April has been a productive month here at Missionary Acres. Last week, two men operating a gutter business in LaCrosse, WI drove down and worked on replacing some old gutters around the property.

Unfortunately, because Bryan was in water class, he could only help one of those days. However, the rest of the staff and the men installed brand new gutters on many houses. Sadly, we could not get to all the buildings that needed done, but praise God, the owner returned this week and even more gutters are being replaced. Working gutters are definitely a blessing, especially with the amount of rain we've been getting.

We also have a volunteer group from Owatonna and Albert Lea, MN, working on the new construction project for the Galvan family. They have been framing the interior walls, installing windows and doors, and building a deck. Praise God for the fantastic progress being made. Work groups and volunteers are able to accomplish so much more than the staff can on our own.

While much of the staff and the team worked on the new build, Bryan has focused his attention on a remodel project. This particular house needed a lot of electrical work in the attic. With the outside temperatures rising, he has been putting in many hours and some late nights trying to get that part of the job done. Praise God, unless some surprises come along, the attic work is nearly complete, with only one more circuit to be tied in. Lord willing, that'll be done in the next few days.

There is some rush on the attic for two reasons. First, because it is getting warmer, and second, because our family will be on the road again soon. On April 28th, we will be loading up the van and making another ministry trip.
