Missionary Acres Update

Many work teams have dedicated time to Missionary Acres this year, and it is really showing. Projects are moving forward, and maintenance is getting completed. Please continue to pray for our work teams. We have three more coming this year, including one from one of our supporting churches: Bethel Baptist Church in Salem, Oregon.

Please pray for the groups still scheduled for this year and continue to pray that additional groups will commit to coming next year. We're so thankful for all the folks who sacrificed and gave their time to serve here at the Acres. They're the reason so much has been accomplished this year, and we're eagerly anticipating more groups to work on the many ongoing projects.

We are still focusing on both a major remodel project, and a new build. But we also have many other homes that are currently empty. All need at least some work to be completed before we can place new occupants in them.

As a result of the backlog of work to be done, Missionary Ares is not currently accepting, nor considering, applications for residency. That way, new residents won't have to live in temporary housing while waiting for their home to get finished.

However, we know that retiring pastors and missionaries are looking for a place to live. So, our most urgent need at this time is to get those houses ready so we can resume the application process. In the short term, we make the most progress towards that goal with the help of volunteer labor. Long term will are also looking for additional staff members who can join the team.
