Multiple trips to the doctor have resulted in diagnoses of the flu, COVID, bronchitis, and most recently pneumonia. He is currently on his third round of antibiotics, so please pray that he'd start feeling better soon.

We started homeschooling prior to our trip to Texas but enjoyed a break during our travels. We're now in full gear again. We wrapped up a unit study on castles and are now working through one on Little House on the Prairie. It's such a joy to study and learn together for part of each school day!
