This has been a busy year here at Missionary Acres, but again we are thankful for God's goodness to us. We are praising God that the Lot 68 Remodel is complete, and the Habegger family arrived to the Acres yesterday. We'll be helping unload the moving truck today! It'll be a joy to help get them settled.

We want to thank Ken (our project manager) and Daniel (a full-time volunteer) for their hard work on this project. The tile floor in much of this house had a lot of cracking in the grout lines. We suspect it was due to the way the grout was originally installed as it apparently cracked right away, and never really got worse over time.

It took a lot of labor from Ken and Daniel to remove the old grout. Then Bryan and Ken were able to regrout the floor. It took about 60 pounds of grout to completely redo the main floor in the house, but it looks amazing and should last for many years!

Bryan helped to get the house primed for paint, but it was Daniel that put in the extra hours to complete the painting in the house. It looks great!
